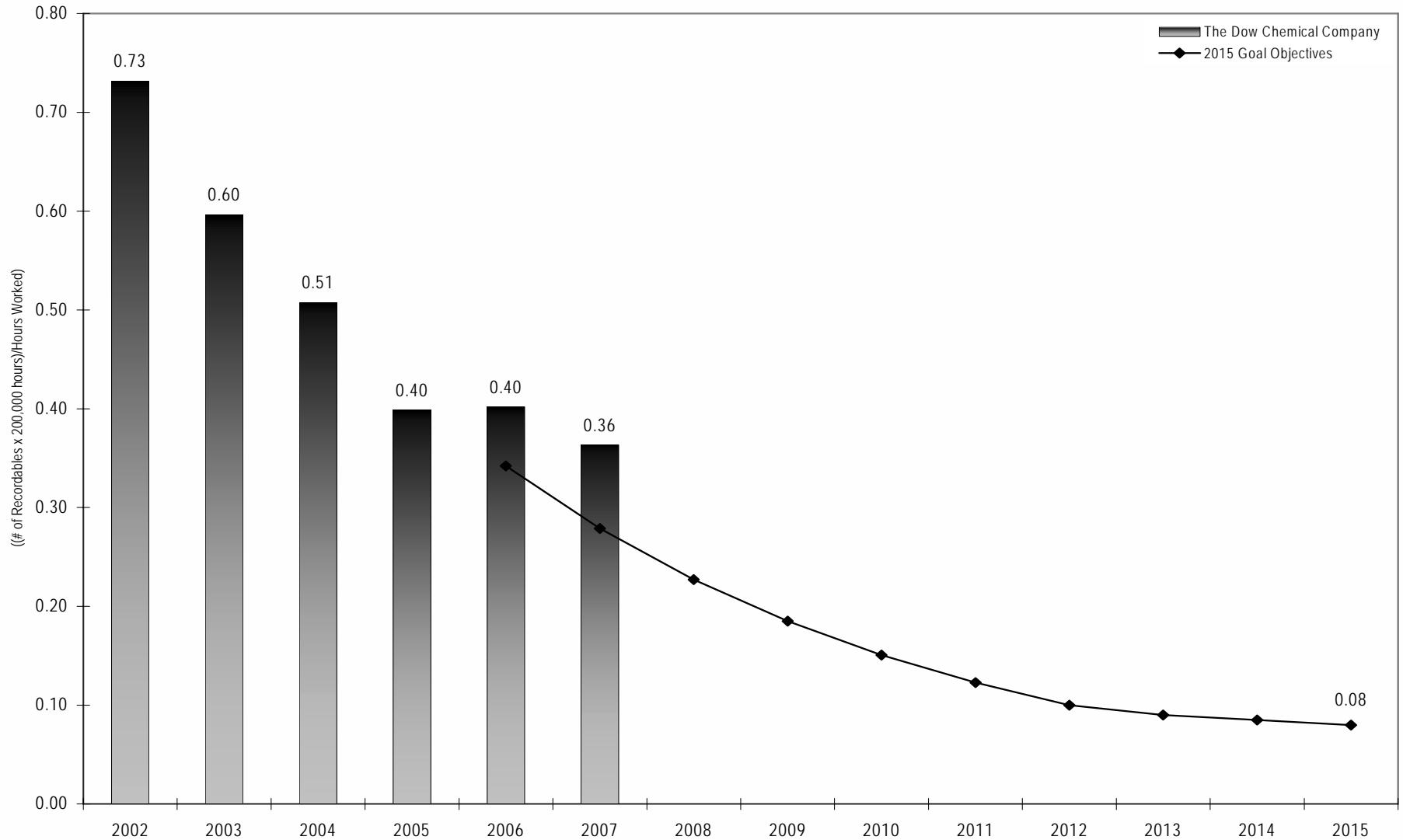


Key Messages

- **Injury/Illness** – The injury/illness rate through the 1Q2007 was 0.36 (incidents/200,000 hours. This is 10% improved over the 2006 performance.
- **Loss of Primary Containment** – Through 1Q2007, there were 101 incidents for an annualized count of 404, which is an improvement of 31% over 2006.
- **Process Safety** – There were nine (9) Process Safety Code Measurement Incidents reported within Dow during the first quarter of 2007. The annualized count of 36 is an improvement over 2006's total of 37.
- **Motor Vehicle Accident** – There were 91 motor vehicle accidents through 1Q2007, which was a rate of 3.4 accidents per million miles driven.
- **Notice of Violations/Compliance Orders** – There were 10 NOVs received in 1Q2007. An annualized figure for 2007 would be 40, which is a 50% reduction from 2006 performance. No Compliance Orders were reported in 1Q2007.
- **Government Reportables** – There were 20 reportable quantity exceedences and 8 permit/regulatory exceedences reported for 1Q2007. Annualizing 1Q2007 reportable quantity exceedences yields 80 for the year, which would be a 33% decrease from 2006, continuing a steady downward trend.
- **Fines & Penalties** – The actual dollars paid in fines in 1Q2007 was \$31,249.
- **Transportation** – Through the first quarter of 2007, eleven serious or moderate Transportation Incidents have occurred. The Transportation Incident Rate for this quarter is 0.20 (per 10,000 shipments).

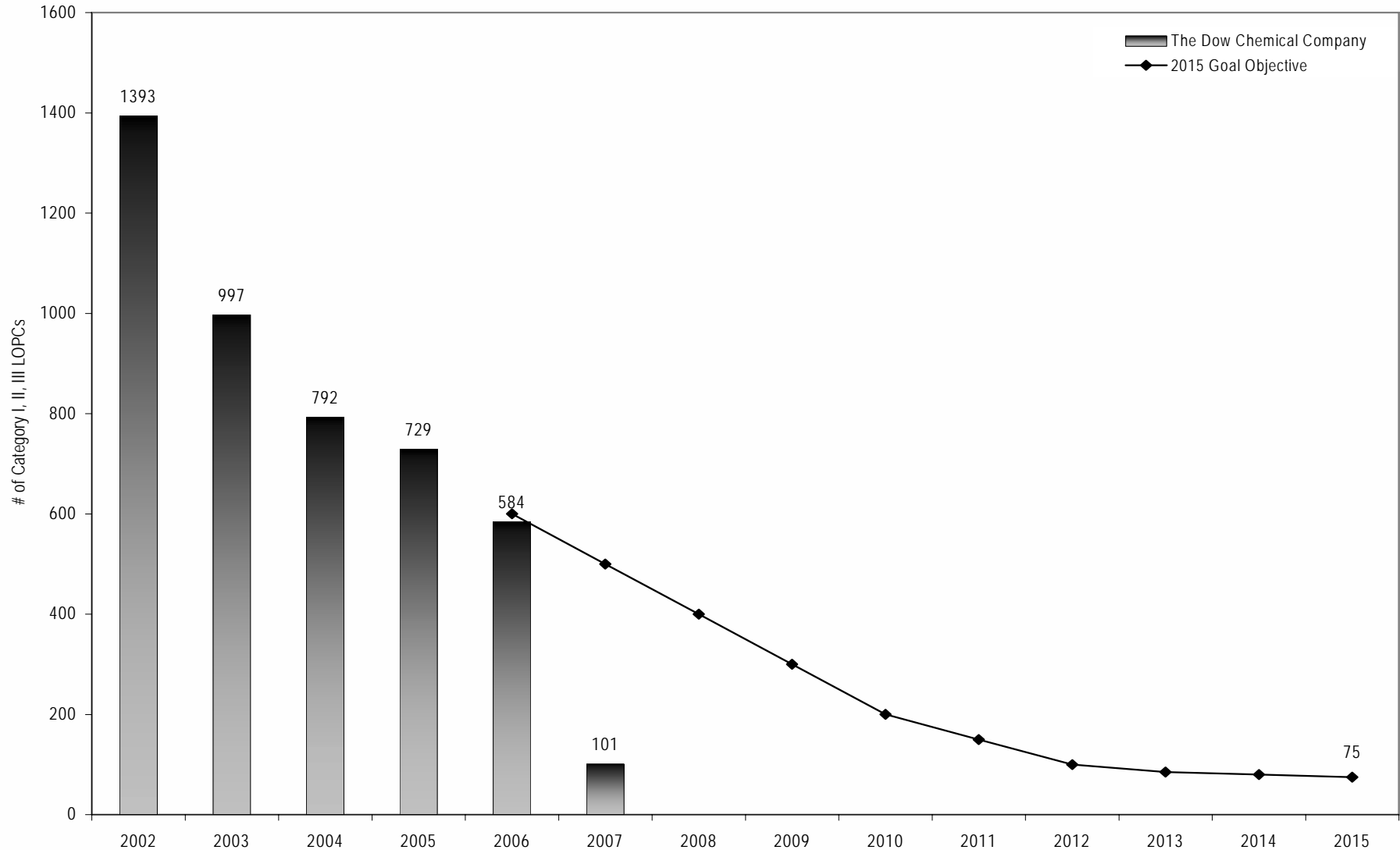


Employee + Contractor Injury/Illness Rate The Dow Chemical Company



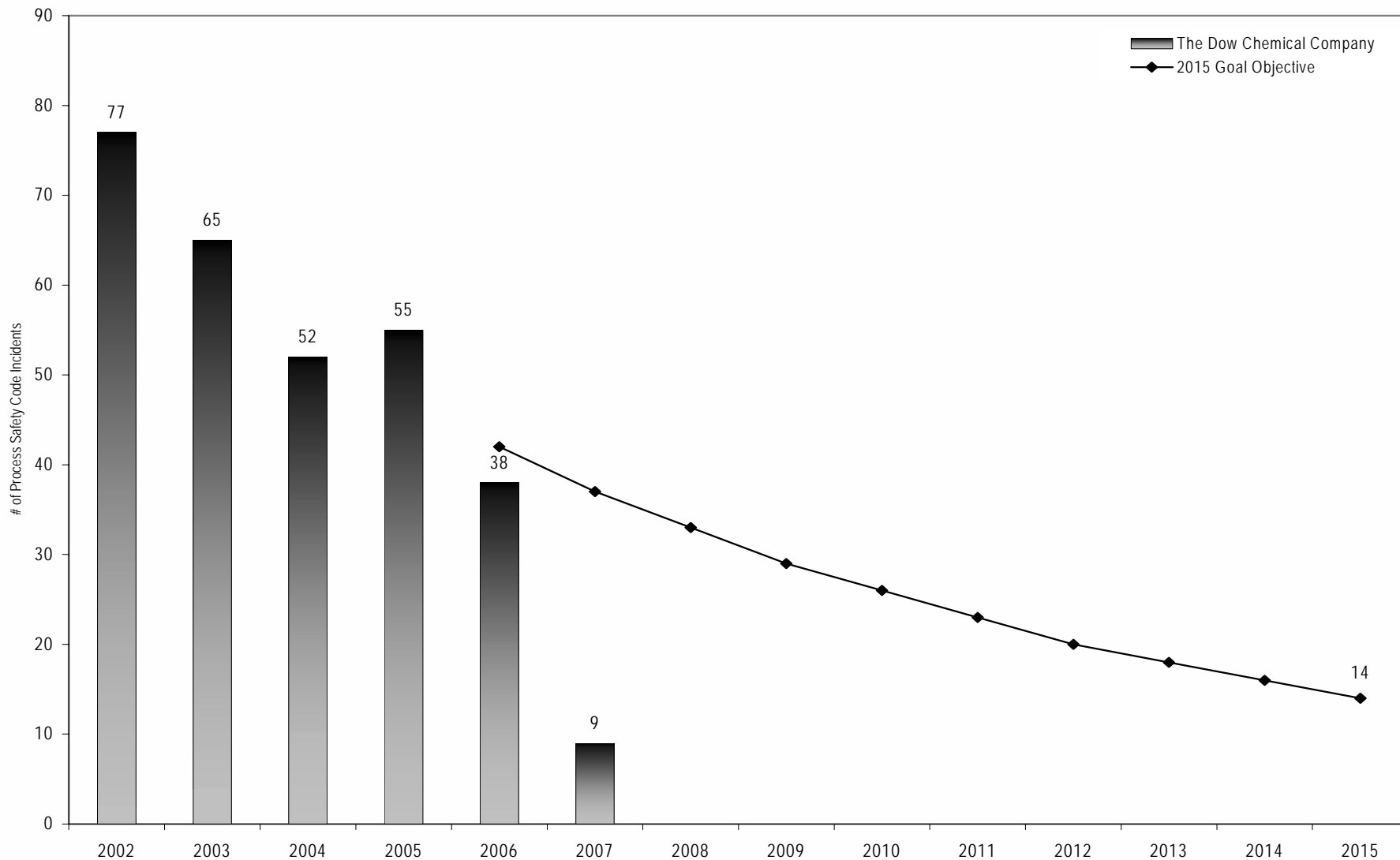


Loss of Primary Containment The Dow Chemical Company



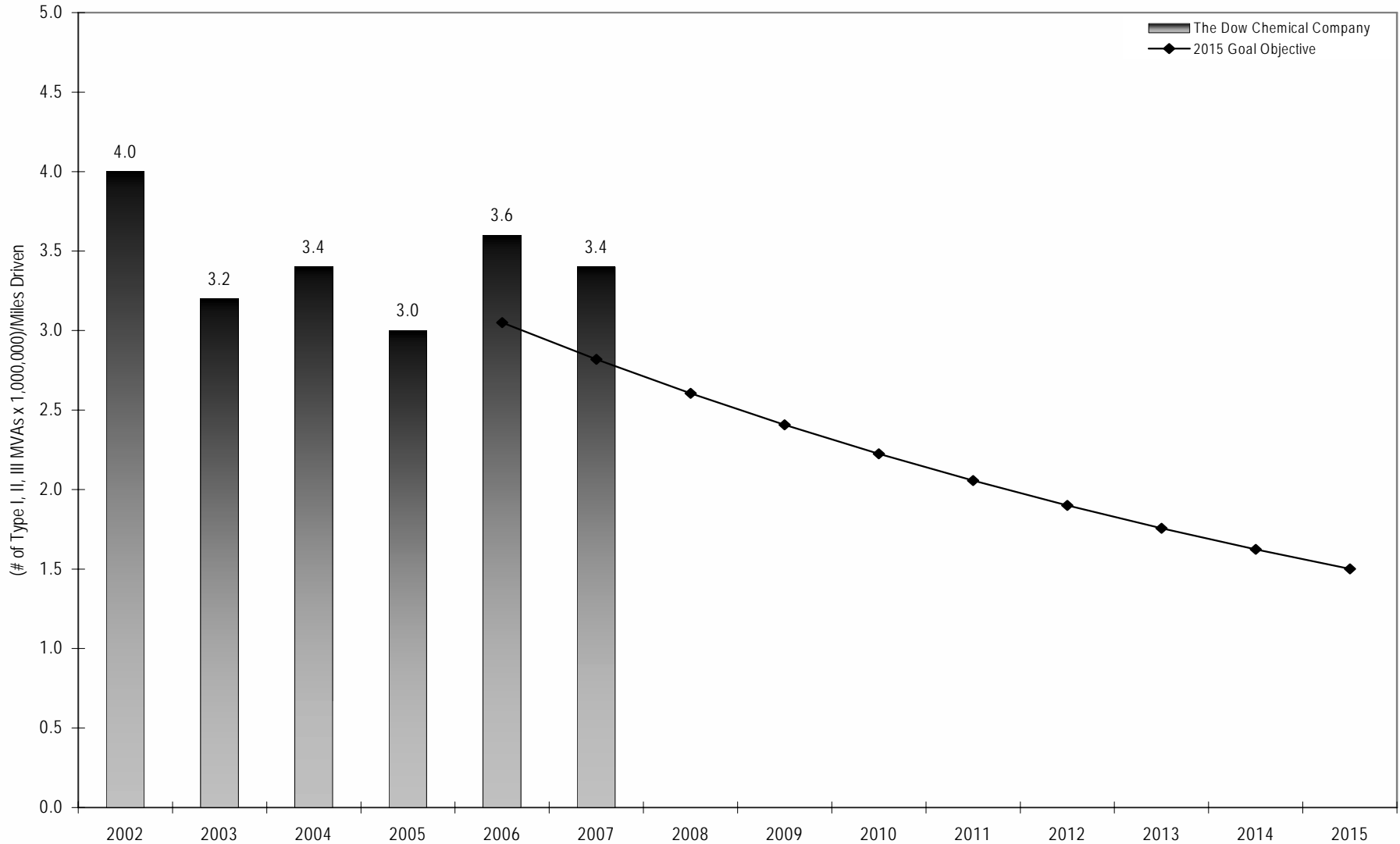


Process Safety Code The Dow Chemical Company



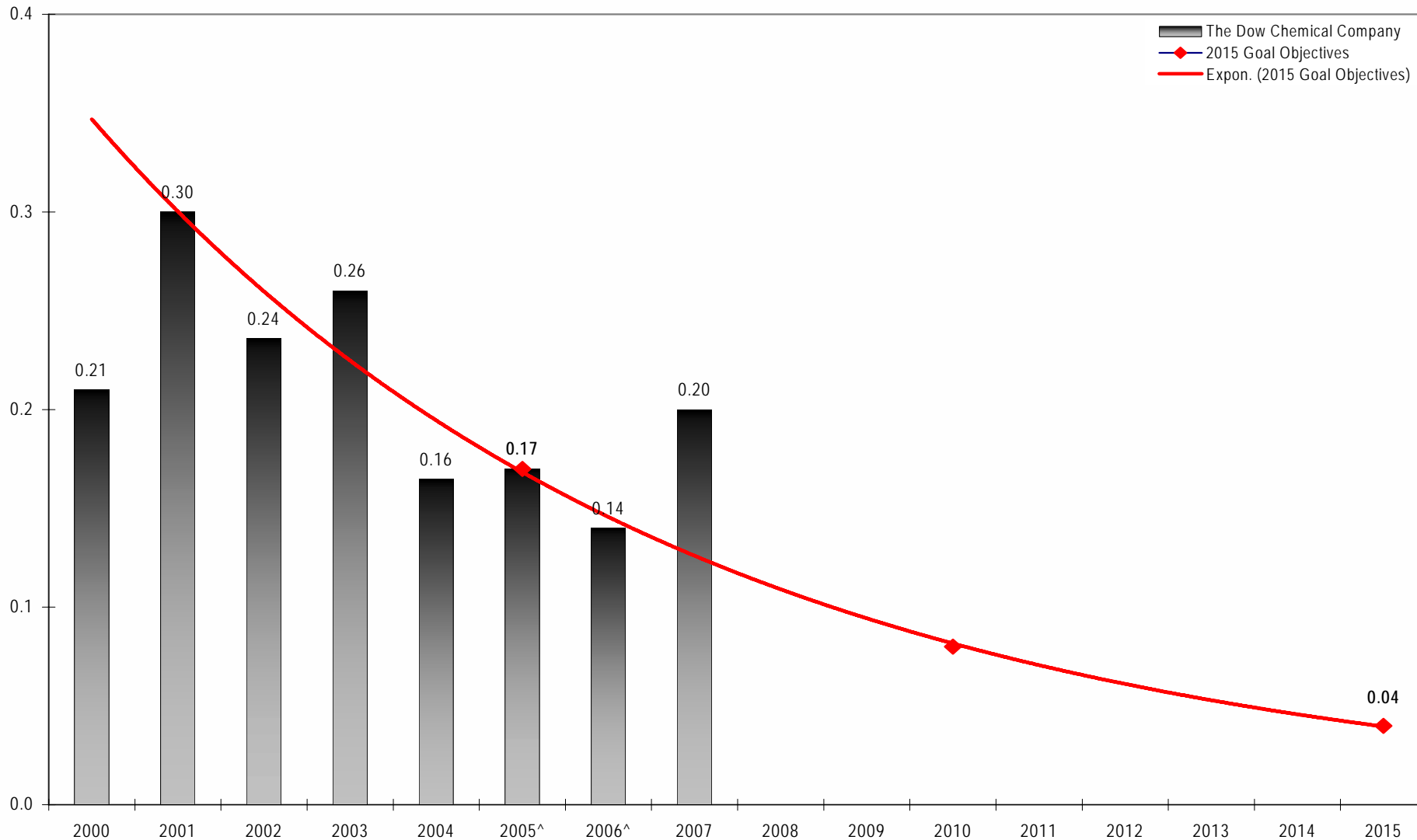


Motor Vehicle Accident Rate The Dow Chemical Company



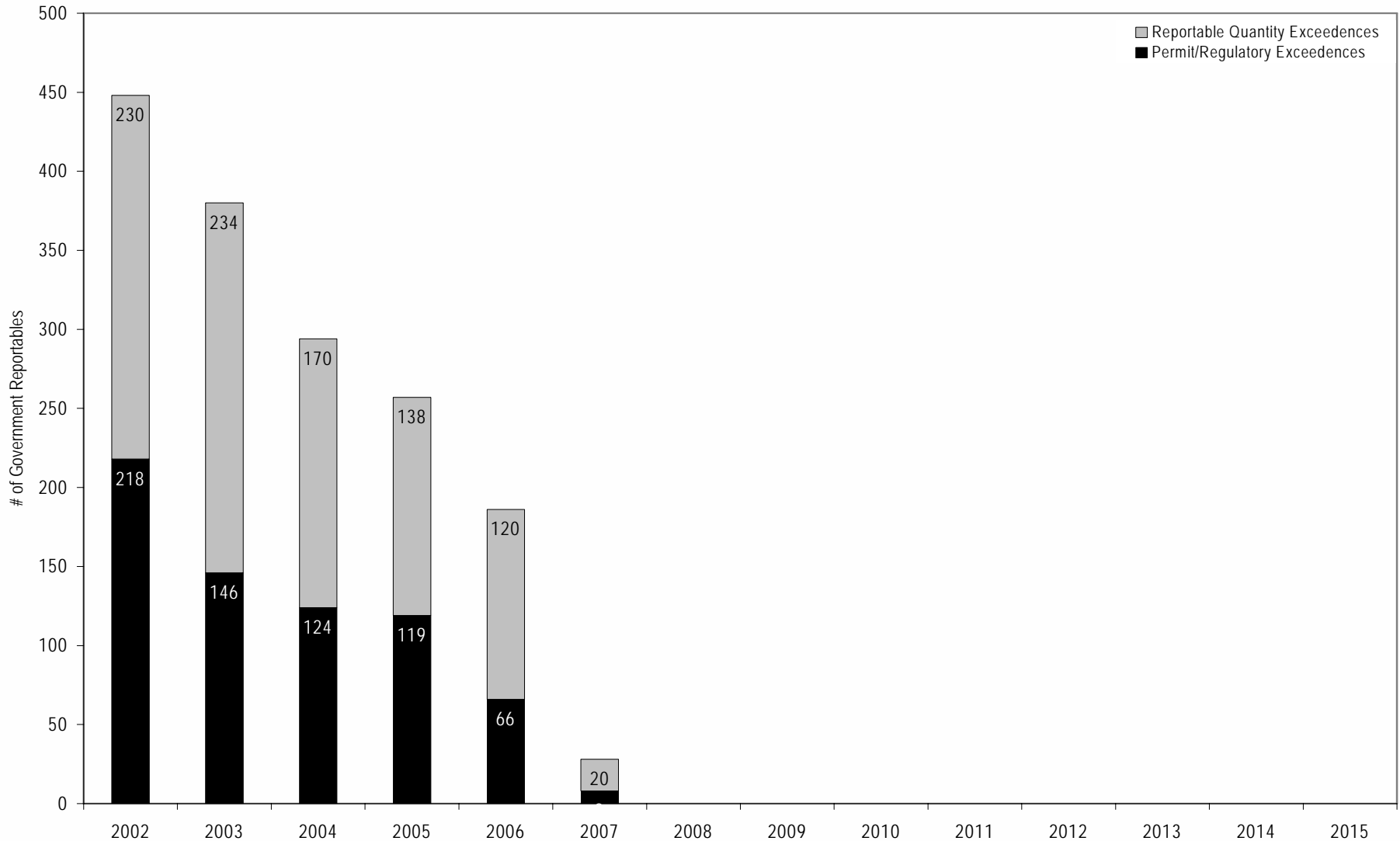


Transportation The Dow Chemical Company



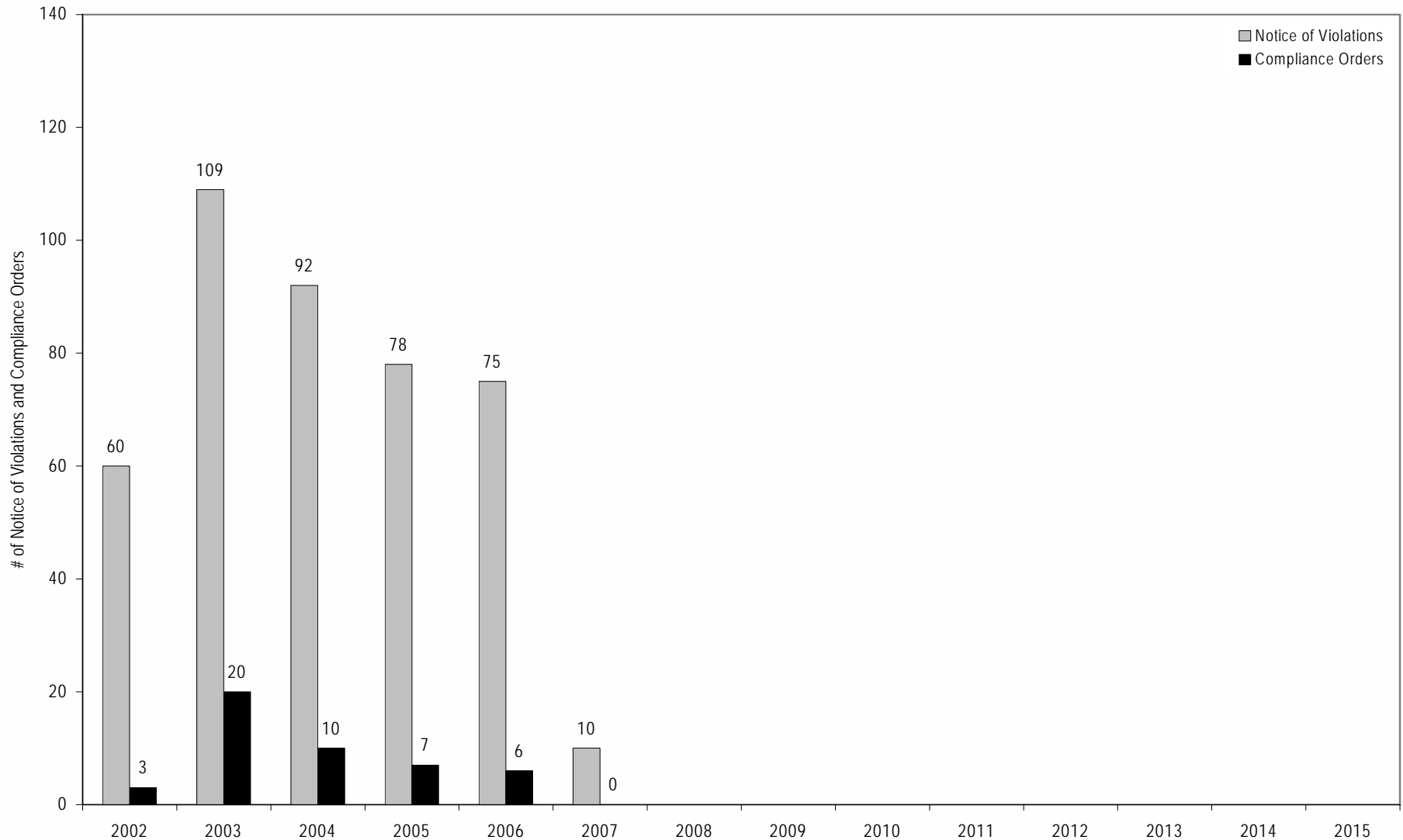
